

SCRIPT: "Jailtron"

LOGLINE: Victim of his own invention, a scientist and his son struggle to escape the grip of an international criminal organization.

SYNOPSIS: After years of research, Dr. John Colloway, a nano technology scientist, discovers a new way to miniaturize matter, including people. A group of international criminals headed by a very powerful leader, Jake Toner, have followed Dr. Colloway's career and decide to use his discovery to create the first nano jail in the world. Lured by the promise of millions of dollars in research money, Dr. Colloway agrees to the multi billion dollar project and helps build Jailtron, which starts taking prisoners from all over the world and becomes a successful business and jail model.

But Jake's hidden agenda is to also establish a cocaine production plant at Jailtron, after his scientists discover that the human liver in miniaturized people convert the nicotine from smoking into a form of cocaine, instead of conitine. Unknown to Jailtron smoking inmates, they have become a cocaine producing organism.

After Dr. Colloway's assistant, Bob, discovers the nicotine-cocaine connection and gets killed for it, Dr. Colloway realizes that his ex-wife Annie, who had performed research on nicotine years before, may have also been killed for the same discovery.

Cornered by Jake's massive intelligence apparatus, Dr. Colloway and his son decide to use the same nano technology to send a computer virus into the past that sends emails to the authorities, pointing to a single event in Jake's past that can bring him to justice: a compromising meeting with John Hinckley Jr., the night before he shot President Reagan.

As a result of bringing Jake to justice in the past, Dr. Colloway's new alternate future is replaced, along with his assistant Bob and his wife Annie.
